#### T/ Accounts Monitor Report

We have checked the general budget of the National Institute for Human Rights / Kirkuk as in 31/December/2017 and the accounts for the activity result and data and disclosures for the period ended with the same date and the annual report of the National Institute for Human Rights - Kirkuk, prepared under the provisions of the NGO Law No. 21 of 1997 and its instructions.

We have obtained the information and clarifications that we have seen are necessary to carry out our mission, which we have done in accordance with the legislation in force and in accordance with the recognized audit, which included the necessary tests of the center activity within our terms of reference, and we have the following observations:

The National Institute of Human Rights, Kirkuk/Iraq, was established under registration leave No. 38618 in 8/11/2012, issued by the General Secretariat of the Council of Ministers/Non-governmental organization service

- 1. The inventory of fixed and traded assets has been properly managed by the Centre and the results of the inventory are identical for the balances of Control records. The Department has been supporting the documentation in support of these procedures.
- 2. The Centre deals in foreign currency (dollar) and is funded through foreign grants and the exchange rate (1200) is approved for all its transactions, but the center did not receive a grant during the year.
- 3. The balance of creditors during the year amounted to 1710573 IQD.

In our view, as far as we have come through our examination and according to what is recorded in the Office's records and according to the information and clarifications given to us, the book collection used by the office administration was in accordance with the requirements of the bookkeeping system and, in our estimation, included the recording of all assets, liabilities and expenditures of the Office.

The annual report and its inclusion reflected in a comprehensive manner the march of the Office during the year under the report.

the final statements and accounts were organized in accordance with the established accounting rules and legislation and are in full conformity with the records shown by the registers and are regulated in accordance with the Companies Act No. 21 of 1997 (amended) and the regulations and instructions issued thereunder, the attached general budget reflects the financial position of the Office at the date of 31/12/2018 and the result accounts show its excess activity for the period ended with the same date.
